Adopting the 2027 San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority Governing Board Meeting Schedule

Whereas, the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority (“Authority”) was established by the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority Act, California Government Code Section 66700 et seq. as a regional entity to generate and allocate resources for the protection and enhancement of tidal wetlands and wildlife habitat in San Francisco Bay and along its shoreline; and

Whereas, the Authority is subject to the Ralph M. Brown Act (“Brown Act”), Government Code Section 54950, et seq., which requires the Authority to establish a schedule for holding its regular meetings.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Governing Board of the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority hereby adopts the 2027 San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority Governing Board Meeting Schedule set forth below.
