SUBJECT: Upcoming Public Events in Economically Disadvantaged Communities along the Shoreline of San Francisco Bay

At the October 15, 2021, Governing Board meeting, staff provided an update on implementation of the equity recommendations made by the Advisory Committee and adopted by the Governing Board. One of the recommendations not yet implemented was, “1.5 Visit economically disadvantaged communities residing along the bay shoreline with the Governing Board, Advisory Committee, and Authority staff to better understand issues and potential opportunities.”

Staff intends to schedule a board tour including shoreline sites in economically disadvantaged communities when public health conditions permit, most likely in the spring or summer of 2022. In the meantime, staff will provide updates on other opportunities for members of the Governing Board and the Advisory Committee to participate in public events organized by Authority grantees in economically disadvantaged communities.
