SUBJECT: Proposed 2023 Board Tour Schedule

In response to the Governing Board's request, staff has prepared the following list of proposed board tours in 2023. We suggest a schedule of four one-day tours spread throughout the year, visiting one or more projects in each Bay region. The focus of the tours will be visiting projects funded by the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority that benefit economically disadvantaged communities, and the details of each tour will be developed collaboratively with grantees and other partners. The specific projects visited may change based on availability of partners and site conditions. Once each tour itinerary is finalized, it will be publicly announced in accordance with the requirements of the Brown Act.

Tour 1: North Bay, Spring

- San Pablo Baylands Collaborative Protection and Restoration (CPR) Project, Cullinan Ranch site, near the City of Vallejo.
- Tiscornia Marsh Restoration and Sea Level Rise Adaptation Project in the City of San Rafael.
- Marin City Urban Wetland Community Visioning Project.

Tour 2: East Bay, Summer

- North Richmond Shoreline Living Levee Project.
- Berkeley North Basin Project.
- Bay Restoration: Youth Engagement and Service Learning in East Oakland at Martin Luther King, Jr. Regional Shoreline.

Tour 3: West Bay, Fall

- Heron's Head Park Shoreline Resilience Project in the Bayview Hunters Point neighborhood of San Francisco.
- Candlestick Point Stewardship Project in the Bayview Hunters Point neighborhood San Francisco.

- Colma Creek Restoration and Adaptation Project in the City of South San Francisco.

Tour 4: South Bay, Winter

- South San Francisco Bay Shoreline Project.
- South Bay Salt Ponds Restoration Project, Alviso site.
- Calabaza/San Tomas Aquino Creek-Marsh Connection Project.
