

### Benefits of the Pre-application Process

- Agency collaboration to avoid conflicting guidance
- Early coordination to avoid conflicts between public access and wildlife habitat
- Help navigating new restoration permitting tools
- Agencies receiving more complete permit applications




### Projects

#### **BRRIT** Performance

- Permits issued to meet project construction schedules
